MINUTES

October 25, 2022

Opening Statement: Mayor Maglio called the meeting of the Walpack Mayor and Committee to order at 7:00 P.M. and stated that the meeting was being held in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act, having been duly advertised.

Approval of Minutes: Mayor Maglio requested a Motion to approve the September 27, 2022 Mayor and Committee Meeting Minutes. Motion by Committeewoman Wycalek. Second by Deputy Mayor Heigis. All in Favor.

Resolutions:

R-39-22 RESOLUTION approving bills and vouchers for payment (Bills list attached) Mayor Maglio requested a Motion to approve R-39-22. Motion by Committeewoman Wycalek. Second by Deputy Mayor Heigis. All in Favor.

New Business: Attorney Kienz advised, as Engineer Michael Vreeland is not a paid municipal employee, that there is no escrow to be paid through Walpack Township specific to work he has done regarding the Heigis and Maglio properties, and that his fees shall be paid directly by the applicants."
